

Emergency Broadband Benefit Program

Receive a temporary discount on monthly broadband bills

The Federal Communications Commission is offering a program that provides a temporary discount on monthly broadband bills for qualifying households. If your household is eligible, you can receive:

- Up to \$50 a month discount on your broadband service and associated equipment rentals
- A one-time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, tablet, or desktop computers where available

Only one monthly discount and one device is allowed per household.

DO YOU QUALIFY?

You must participate in **one** of these government benefit programs:

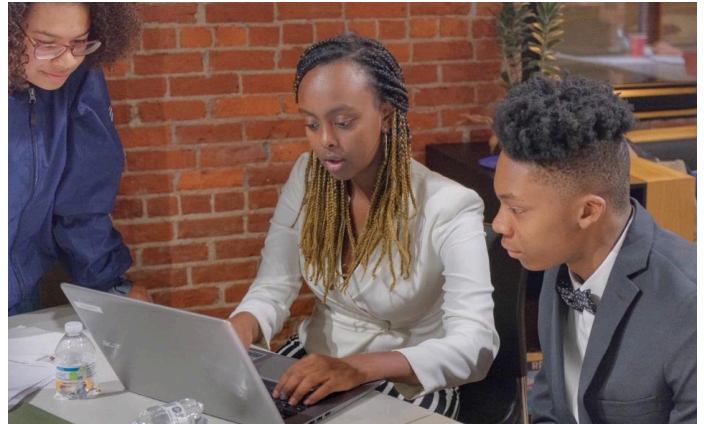
- Lifeline
- SNAP
- Medicaid
- Federal Public Housing Assistance (FHPA)
- Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Free and reduced priced school lunch, breakfast
- Federal Pell Grant

OR: Your household experienced a substantial loss of income due to job loss or furlough since 2/29/20 and your household income in 2020 was the same or less than \$99,000 for single filers or \$198,000 for joint filers.

OR: Your income is at or below 135% of the federal poverty guidelines.

THREE WAYS TO APPLY

1. Contact a participating broadband provider directly to learn about their application process



2. Visit www.getemergencybroadband.org to apply
3. Call 833-511-0311 for a mail-in application or print a copy, and return it along with copies of documents showing proof of eligibility
